



Duration

Requirements/Prerequisite

Course Structure:

1. Video Learning

Before the live-sessions, you will watch short video lectures lasting 60 to 120 minutes and complete assignments to cement your understanding of the videos.

2. Live Sessions

The live-sessions are held in hybrid format, beginning with a review of the video lecture, and followed by a discussion of the case of the day.
