

Prof. Frese (appointments NUS Business School, London Business School, University of Amsterdam, etc., former president of IAAP) is the most highly cited management scientist in Malaysia and Asia (ca 90,000 citations); research spans many topics, e.g., stress at work, personal initiative, error management, organizational culture & change, innovation in Asia, training for entrepreneurial success, authored 190 journal articles, 250 book contributions, 30 books and special issues.

Yi-Ren Wang is Associate Professor I of Organizational Behavior and Faculty Director of Mindset Lab: Leading for Growth at the Asia School of Business. She received her PhD in Management from the University of Alabama. She received her master's degree in Industrial and Organizational Psychology from the University at Albany, State University of New York, and her bachelor's degree in Psychology from National Taiwan University. Her research focuses on precarious work, workplace inequality, work motivation, and wellbeing, with the aim of reducing social disparities and promoting socioeconomic mobility.

Her work has been published in international peer-reviewed journals, including the Journal of Applied Psychology, Journal of Organizational Behavior, and Journal of Business and Psychology. She received the 2024 Schmidt-Hunter Meta-Analysis Award and the 2022 S. Rains Wallace Dissertation Award from the Society for Industrial and Organizational Psychology (SIOP).
