PROGRAMS OFFERED

Executive Education

The iCLIF Executive Education Centre at ASB – ***the first in Malaysia to debut in the Financial Times Top 100 Executive Education Custom Rankings*** – delivers high-impact programs in leadership, management, sustainability, corporate governance, finance, geopolitics, and technology. Grounded in world-class research and supported by executive coaching, iCLIF serves approximately 7,000 executives annually. The Centre, along with ASB faculty, also provides advisory services to firms, usually involving Boards of Directors and senior leaders.

Micro-credentials

ASB's micro-credential programs, known as Agile Continuous Education (ACE), offers modular, stackable hybrid courses designed for continuous professional development. ACE certificates can be accumulated into recognized micro-credentials and may be applied toward entry into ASB's MBA and EMBA programs, as well as selected international postgraduate pathways with leading global universities.

Master of Business Administration (MBA)

The 12-month full-time MBA combines rigorous classroom learning with immersive Action Learning experiences across Asia. Anchored in ASB's philosophy of Global Inquiry, Local Heart and MIT's Mind and Hand, the program includes up to three weeks of immersion at MIT Sloan in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Graduates may pursue international postgraduate pathways with leading global business schools*.

Executive MBA (EMBA)

The 16-month EMBA is designed for accomplished professionals and delivered through modular and hybrid weekend formats. The program emphasizes strategic leadership, analytical rigor, and global perspective, and includes up to three weeks of immersion at MIT Sloan, with optional international postgraduate pathways*.

Master in Central Banking (MCB)

The MCB is a one-year residential program designed primarily for central bankers. It includes a six-week immersion at MIT Sloan and focuses on systems thinking, innovation, and global best practices in central banking, financial supervision, and monetary and financial stability, with optional international postgraduate pathways*.

PhD in Management

The PhD in Management prepares individuals for advanced research careers in academia, industry, and policymaking. Candidates receive rigorous research training and are empowered to contribute to the advancement of knowledge in economics, business, and management.
